CIRCULAR 10 OF 2006

NATIONAL HEALTH REFERENCE PRICE LIST 2006: RELEASE OF VERSION 2006.06

1. Version 2006.06 of the National Health Reference Price List 2006 has been released. The changes in this version will become effective on **Wednesday 1 March 2006**. A full change log is attached, but the major changes are explained in this circular.

Radiology

2. The notes and structure of the radiology schedule have been amended to make it clear that "025" practices may only charge the codes with a 3rd digit of 9, "038" practices may charge all codes except codes with a 3rd digit of 9, and practitioners registered as both radiologists and nuclear physicians may charge all codes.

Medical Practitioners

3. The NHRPL erred in applying the incorrect rand conversion factor to codes 5820 to 5826. This has been corrected.
4. Modifiers 0020, 0028, 0030 and 0100 were inadvertently omitted from the NHRPL. This has been corrected.
5. The wording of 0166 to 0169 has been corrected to refer to first hospital consultations only, and is now brought in line with the SAMA Doctors' Billing Manual. Code 0164 has also been added to the wording of 0129.

Dental Practitioners


6. Modifier 8002 (GDP fee + 50% for specialists) previously was intended to apply to codes 8201, 8202, 8325 and 8327.
7. Modifier 8002 has now been deleted, and the value of:

- a. codes 8201 and 8202 has been corrected for maxillo-facial surgeons to the value of the general dental practitioner + 50%;
- b. codes 8325 and 8327 has been corrected for prosthodontists to the value of the general dental practitioner + 50%.

Psychometrists

- 8. The psychometry list has been expanded to accommodate the related discipline of registered counselling, which has the practice type 081.
- 9. Further information about this discipline is provided in a copy of a letter from the Chairperson: PsySSA Tariffs and Private Practice Committee (Annexure A).

re: NATIONAL HEALTH REFERENCE PRICE LIST 2006 FOR REGISTERED COUNSELLORS

I have consulted with the Registered Counsellors, the Health Professions Council of South Africa (HPCSA), and the President of the Psychological Society of South Africa (PsySSA). The following issues are relevant:

1 TIME/SESSION LIMITATION

According to the HPCSA Professional Board for Psychology Framework for Education, Training and Registration as a Registered Counsellor, the original scope of practice reads:

“Registered Counsellors may only provide psychological services within the same client system for a maximum of six hours. However, where the Registered Counsellor is working for an organization and presents a psycho-education programme in a community setting, the nature of the programme may require that the limit of six hours be slightly extended.” (page 4)

The Minutes of the Third Meeting of the Executive Committee and Heads of the Departments of Psychology at Universities dated 2003-02-10 indicates on page 2 that, *“registered counsellors were limited to four sessions not exceeding six hours in total within the same client system”*.

A document received from the President of PsySSA, Prof Foxcroft, entitled ‘BPsych Registered Counsellor: A Professional Category Created to Meet Needs of SA Population at Primary Level – Professional Board for Psychology, HPCSA’, indicates on page 7, *“Up to four sessions, not exceeding six hours in total within the same client system”*.

I have been in contact with the office of Ms Alta Pieters who is the Manager: Professional Board for Psychology at the HPCSA and her assistant has forwarded me copies of the Government Gazette of 2005-11-04 where Government Notice No. R. 1073 indicates that, *“The Minister of Health, in terms of section 61(2) of the Health Professions Act, 1973 (Act No. 56 of 1974), hereby withdraws regulations 3(3), and 6 of the Regulations Relating to*

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the Registration of Registered Counsellors in terms of the Health Professions Act as published in the Government Notice R1820 of 19 December 2003". Paragraph 3(3) in the Government Gazette No. 25837 of 2003-12-19 reads as follows:

"3(3) A person registered as a registered counsellor in terms of regulation 3(2) shall be limited to practice his or her profession in a public sector, non-governmental and community-based organisation and shall be limited to practice in a specific field in which he or she has undertaken training by an institution whose training has been approved by the board."

Paragraph 6 discusses Registration of Categories for Registered Counsellors. Nowhere in this document is there any reference to time or session limitations being imposed on Registered Counsellors. Paragraph 9 indicates, *"The regulations published in the Government Gazette as Government Notice No. 553 of 22 June 2001 are hereby repealed"*. Unfortunately I have been unable to obtain a copy of the Government Gazette of 22 June 2001.

It, therefore, appears that Registered Counsellors have no limitations or restrictions regarding time or sessions spent with a client.

2 PRACTICE FIELDS

The document entitled 'BPsych Registered Counsellor: A Professional Category Created to Meet Needs of SA Population at Primary Level – Professional Board for Psychology, HPCSA' indicates on page 6 that Registered Counsellors *"may practice in one or two practice fields"*. The HPCSA Professional Board for Psychology Framework for Education, Training and Registration as a Registered Counsellor (page 2) indicates that these practice fields are as follows:

- Psychometrics
- Career Counselling
- Trauma Counselling
- Primary Mental Health
- Family Counselling
- School Counselling
- Sport Counselling
- HIV/AIDS Counselling
- Human Resources
- Pastoral Counselling
- Employee Relations and Wellbeing

This would be a limitation in that Registered Counsellors may only work within in their field of expertise in which they qualified to a maximum of two fields.

3 PRIMARY INTERVENTION LEVEL

As per page 6 of the 'BPsych Registered Counsellor: A Professional Category Created to Meet Needs of SA Population at Primary Level – Professional Board for Psychology, HPCSA', this *"category [has been] created to meet SA population needs at primary*

intervention level". The same document on page 7 indicates that Registered Counsellors "*must know when to refer*" a client for specialised intervention. This would be a further limitation.
