



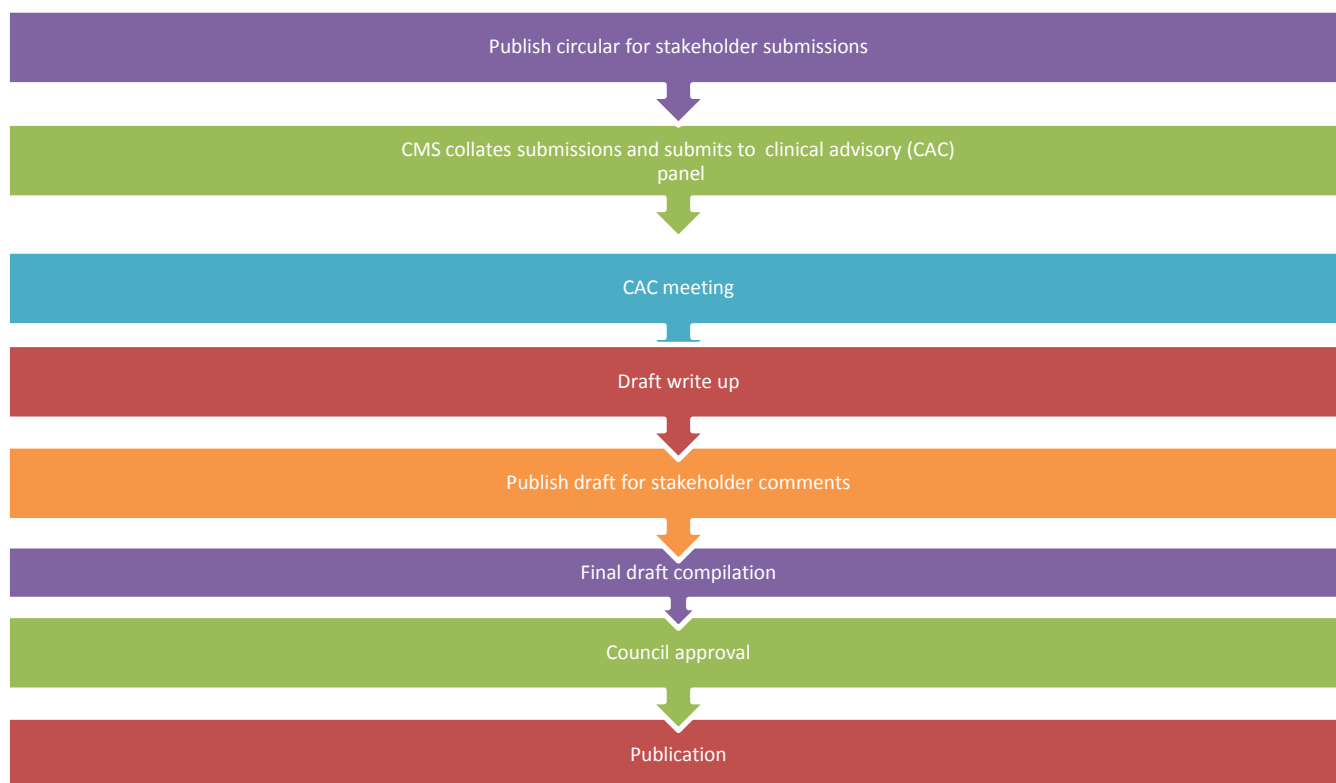

## **CIRCULAR 52 OF 2017 : BENEFIT DEFINITION SUBMISSIONS FOR GYNAECOLOGY ONCOLOGY CONDITIONS**

The Council for Medical Schemes (CMS) is calling for submissions for the following gynaecology oncology conditions:

- ovarian cancer
- endometrial cancer
- cervical cancer
- dysplasia of the cervix and cervical carcinoma; cervical condylomata
- vulvar cancer
- vaginal cancer

While the CMS acknowledges the PMB review process that is currently underway, a gap has been identified in the management of some conditions, which warrants continuous development of practice guidelines while the review process is underway. These guidelines will be appraised and updated once the PMB review process is finalized. The procedure for the PMB definition process is outlined below:
