RENAISSANCE HEALTH MEDICAL SCHEME ("the scheme")
(IN LIQUIDATION)
MASTERS REF. NO. G1200/08

1. As you will be aware the scheme was placed under winding up by Order of the High Court of South Africa (WLD) dated 17th October 2008
2. From information provided to us, the scheme appears to be insolvent to the tune of R60m – R80m. We have commenced investigations into the reasons for the demise of the scheme with a view to *inter alia*, identifying potential sources of recovery of funds. This process is obviously one that will take some time to complete.
3. You will appreciate that members of the scheme have been left high and dry by virtue of the scheme's poor payment history and now demise. Whilst we are cognizant of the relationship between yourselves (*providers*), members and the scheme we would **request** that you indulge members and exercise patience with regard to recovery proceedings at least until there exists more clarity of and concerning potential recoveries (*if any*) and ultimate awards that may flow therefrom.
